This application must be completed and submitted to Cleveland County Environmental Health to provide information about **ALL** food preparation and/or sales to the public at any public event or exhibition within Cleveland County by the organizer. **Each food vendor/booth MUST complete a separate Temporary Food Establishment (TFE) Application which must be received by the Cleveland County Health Department with a payment of \$75 no less than 15 days prior to the event.** Some food vendors may be exempt, and payment may not be required, but **ALL** food vendors **MUST** complete a TFE application form.
